

It was a pleasure to host such an esteemed guest, and we are excited for future opportunities to collaborate.










# Mrs. Inga Corlateanu Presents at America House Chisinau During 'Digital Education Week'




#### Countdown to Christmas with Fairy Tales in 2A!






# The Magic of Christmas Begins in December: 1B Students Celebrate the Season

**Christmas Program for Lower Secondary students** 




#### Last Call for Winter Ball Tickets: Don't Miss Out!




#### **Christmas card winners**


